The City of New Westminister Youth Award

»This award recognizes individuals aged 13-18 who have made positive contributions in their community through positive involvement in:

1. Musical or Artistic Activities
2. Athletic Involvement or,
3. Volunteerism

The City of New Westminister Youth Group Award

»This award recognizes youth groups of 3 members or more that have collectively made a positive contribution in the community through their work.

The City of New Westminister Adult Role Model Award

»This award recognizes individuals over the age of 19 who , through their work, attitude, and trust in young people have supported youth development and involvement in their communities

Bridging the Age Gap Award

»This award recognizes youth who through their involvement/ volunteerism have positively impacted the senior's community in New Westminister. Bridging the Age Gap could mean working one on one with seniors, or being involved in the senior community on a larger scale.

Special Youth Category– Anti-Racism Recognition Award

Each year the City of New Westminister will be presenting a special youth award based on a theme that is relevant to the youth community.

»This year the Special Category will be focused on the issue Anti-racism. The Anti-racism Recognition Award will be given to an individual, group, or project which has addressed this issue in our community.

The City of New Westminister Future Leaders Award

»This award recognizes youth who are 11 or 12 years of age who have shown leadership among their peers and have shown they have an interest in becoming more involved in the community to make a difference.
